NCJW invites its members to apply for its new Leadership Program. This program is unique because it is directed to NCJW members and has the goals of providing women with:

- ① training and cultivation of women for future NCJW Board, committee and leadership roles;
- ② leadership skills training that can be valuable in work, synagogue, PTA and volunteer situations;
- ③ awareness of NCJW and its place within the broader St. Louis community;
- ④ opportunity to explore a more enhanced sense of who they are, their potential and power.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

LOCATION: All sessions will be held at the NCJW Offices, 8350 Delcrest, in University City

TIMEFRAME: Five Saturday mornings from 8:30 AM-12:30 PM

COST: \$65 payable to NCJW

(materials provided through the Ruth and Nancy Siteman Leadership Legacy Fund)

NUMBERS: 12-15 women

COMMITMENT: The following is expected:

- ✦ Completion of an application with one letter of reference (employer, friend, etc.)
- ✦ Attendance at all sessions
- ✦ Agreement that within 12 months of program completion to assume a leadership role within NCJW

DATES/TOPICS: The program will expose women to a variety of speakers and presenters. Woven throughout will be skill building, personal exploration and NCJW-St. Louis information. The program will be organized in the following manner:

Session I: October 2, 2010

Focus: •Exploring Effective Communication Skills

Session II: November 6, 2010

Focus: •Understanding the Psychology of Leadership and Leadership Skills

Session III: December 4, 2010

Focus: •Balancing Your Life Among Work, Family and Personal Needs

Session IV: January 15, 2011

Focus: •Understanding the Not-For-Profit World and How It Functions
•Understanding the Internal Structure of NCJW

Session V: February 12, 2011

Focus: •Exploring the St. Louis Community and Region and Where NCJW Fits In
•Utilizing Your Potential
