SUPPORTING MONA.

In the state of Missouri, **it is legal for LGBTQ+-identifying people to be fired from their jobs, evicted from their homes, and denied public accommodations and services** based on their sexual orientation and/or gender identity. The Missouri Nondiscrimination Act (MONA) would illegalize discrimination based on sexual orientation and/or gender identity by extending the Missouri Human Rights Statute to LGBTQ+-identifying people.

OPPOSING THE "BATHROOM BILL."

In 2017, a Missouri Senate bill was proposed that would force trans students to use bathrooms that do not correspond with their gender identities. Similar bills are being introduced nationally, and one was passed in North Carolina in 2016. Though this bill did not reach the floor in Missouri, it will likely be reintroduced in the future and we must continue to vehemently oppose it.
